

Fees for EU Ecolabel valid from 01.01.2026

The European Commission has adopted Commission Regulation 782/2013 amending Annex III to Regulation (EU) No 66/2010 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the EU Ecolabel on fees.

All fees are given exclusive VAT. Norwegian VAT will be added.

**The fee covers the submission of a single product.*

When coordinating applications for multiple products submitted simultaneously within the same case, the fee for each product may be reduced, as the total fee will be calculated based on the number of hours spent (140 €/hour). The total fee for a case (new application or renewal) will never be lower than the fee for a single-product application and never lower than €200 per product or product range with the same function and composition. The total fee for the case will not exceed the applicable fee multiplied by the number of products or product variants included in the case.

¹ Small and medium enterprise as defined by Commission Recommendation 2003/361/EC:

The category of small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) is made up of enterprises which employ fewer than 250 persons and which have an annual turnover not exceeding EUR 50 million, and/or an annual balance sheet total not exceeding EUR 43 million.

²[Developing countries](#) defined as least developed countries, low income countries which are not LDCs and lower middle income countries & territories which are not LDCs.

³Micro-enterprises as defined by Commission Recommendation 2003/361/EC:

Within the SME category, a microenterprise is defined as an enterprise which employs fewer than 10 persons and whose annual turnover and/or annual balance sheet total does not exceed EUR 2 million.

⁴ If the company is either EMAS- or ISO 14001-certified, a reduced application fee is granted, provided that the requirements for the ecolabel are explicitly incorporated into the certification as part of the environmental policy and specific environmental objectives. To obtain the reduction, documentation of the certification must be submitted at the time of application, along with a copy of and reference to the parts of the management system where the ecolabel requirements are explicitly integrated. Reductions are not cumulative.
